

## Impact Report: Tony Gee & RedR UK

### Overview

Since becoming a Patron of RedR UK in 2010, Tony Gee has built a strong and enduring partnership with the charity, supporting its mission to strengthen global disaster response through learning and development. RedR UK equips professionals with the skills needed to respond effectively to humanitarian crises, and Tony Gee's contributions have played a vital role in enabling this work.

Over the course of the partnership, Tony Gee raised nearly £200,000 for RedR UK through a wide range of fundraising activities and staff engagement initiatives.

- Sporting Challenges: Participation in the Three Peaks Challenge and the launch of the RedR Football Tournament.
- Office Fundraisers: Regular quizzes, raffles, and mufti days that brought colleagues together for a shared cause.



## Skills-Based Support

Tony Gee also supported RedR's Humanitarian Skills for Engineers initiative in Uganda, offering technical staff the opportunity to coach engineers working in refugee settlements.

## Impact in Uganda

In the Rwamwanja Refugee Settlement, home to over 78,000 displaced people, RedR's microgrants enabled clean energy solutions that improved safety and health outcomes—especially for women and children.
